

STEICO SE resolves to build an additional production facility for wood fiber insulation materials

 New construction of a production facility for wood fiber insulation materials (dry method) with a maximum capacity of approx. 300,000 cbm/a

Feldkirchen (Munich), 9 March 2017 - STEICO SE (ISIN DE000A0LR9369) has resolved to build an additional production facility for wood fiber insulation materials (dry method). As a result, STEICO is reacting to the ongoing trend toward environmentally friendly insulation material.

STEICO has already recorded continuous growth for wood fiber insulation materials in the past several years - even though the intense competition in the industry has led to continued pressure on prices. Large, fully-integrated production facilities and a high degree of capacity uptake allow profitable production for the STEICO Group in this core segment of the company's business. As the existing production facilities are all operating at close to maximum capacity, the new facility will secure future growth in the wood fiber segment. Wood fiber insulation boards produced using the dry method are preferred for use in building shells, such as in facade or roof renovations.

The new facility will be installed at the Polish production site in Czarnków. The planned total investment is around € 7.5 million and will be financed via the existing syndicated credit agreement. The maximum annual capacity will be

around 300,000 cbm, and the facility is expected to go live at the start of 2018.
